PVAA BASEBALL LEAGUE GENERAL CODE OF CONDUCT

The PVAA Baseball League is a community organization that sponsors youth baseball activity emphasizing FUN, fair play, sportsmanship, athletic, and personal development. Our goals are to instill respect, good sportsmanship, teamwork, and a passion for baseball in all our young athletes. To better achieve this goal, we are outlining a Code of Conduct for all parents, coaches, spectators, and players involved in PVAA Baseball. In order to do so, we have set forth expectations for safe, respectful and sportsmanlike manners for all players, parents, coaches, volunteers, and spectators to adhere to. The Code of Conduct is a written contract between the parents and spectators, players, and coaches to abide by the rules and regulations of the game as well as maintain a cooperative attitude and uphold the ideals of fair play and sportsmanship. This contract is more than just paper; it is the essence of our goals and objectives and thus, adherence to it is of primary importance. Children who wish to play, parents (including their guests), and Coaches who wish to coach on teams sanctioned by PVAA Baseball are required to agree to and to sign this Code of Conduct.

PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Respect your Coaches, teammates, parents, opponents, spectators, and umpires.
2. Always display good sportsmanship. (Games, practice, tournaments, etc.).
3. Never argue with an umpire's call or decision. This includes verbally and/or body language (throwing bat, stomping off, etc.)
4. Never mistreat or mishandle any PVAA Baseball equipment (bats, helmets, etc.) or property (dugouts, fence, bathrooms, etc.).
5. No swearing, harassment, taunting, or inappropriate behavior and/or language will be tolerated.
6. Never fight, or threaten violence to anyone during any PVAA baseball practice, game, event, or tournament.
7. Have a positive attitude, win or lose.
8. Teamwork is not a preference; it is a requirement- Encourage one another.
9. No use of Tobacco, Alcohol, and/or Drugs will be Tolerated.
10. No defaming of coaches, teammates, and/or umpires via any electronic or social media (Facebook, Instagram, Twitter) text messages, etc.
11. Always give your best effort in practices and games. When you fail, do your best again.
12. HAVE FUN!

PARENT/SPECTATOR CODE OF CONDUCT

1. I am aware that no scholarships are being handed out today and children play this game to HAVE FUN.
2. I'll teach my child that doing one's best, and having good sportsmanship is more important than winning!
3. Be the parent/fan/spectator that people want to emulate. This game is about the kids!
4. I will not coach or officiate from the bleachers. I acknowledge that if a player is listening to me or other fans and not his/her coaches, it is considered dangerous for a player to receive mixed directions.
5. I (and my guests) will be a positive role model for my child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, umpires, and spectators.
6. I (and my guest) will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any umpire, coach, player, or parent such a booing or taunting, ridicule or demeaning behavior, or by using any profane language and/or gestures.
7. Be respectful of your coach's decisions. Remember they are the ones that are putting in the extra time and effort.
8. I understand that I, and only I, am in control of my emotions and actions, and realize that acting in an inappropriate manner effects my child and possibly their participation in baseball.
9. No defaming of coaches, players, umpires, and/or other parents via any electronic or social media (Facebook, Instagram, Twitter) text messages, etc.
10. Respect the umpires and refrain from questioning their decisions in a disrespectful or abusive manner.
11. Respect coaches and players of the opposing team both during the play of the game and at its conclusion, win or lose.
12. Understand the use of alcoholic beverages, tobacco products or other illegal substances are strictly prohibited at all PVAA Baseball events.
13. I'll comply with the decisions of league officials and observe all rules, policies and procedures as established or endorsed by PVAA Baseball and Tri-State baseball.
14. I understand that it is my responsibility to go over this code of conducts with my child and set forth the expectation for them!

Discipline Policy/Consequences:

Each player and parent are advised of the following discipline policy and consequences for all inappropriate conduct.

1. All Disciplinary action shall be reviewed by the PVAA baseball board and/or Tri-State Baseball.
2. All actions may include but are not limited to the following repercussions:
 - a. Verbal warning
 - b. Suspension
 - c. Dismissal (without refunds)
 - d. Permanent dismissal from ALL PVAA organization activities including: Football, baseball, softball, and soccer.

By signing, 1) all program participants (players, parents, coaches, volunteers, spectators, etc.) agree to follow the regulations/guidelines set forth by the Tri-State Area Baseball Association and the Potomac Valley Athletic Association, and 2) understand that the PVAA Baseball Board has the power and absolute discretion to uphold these rules in instance of violation of said policies, not limited to suspension or removal of participants from the program/premises.
